**PROCEEDINGS:**

Based on the orders of the Government, orders were issued in the Board's Proceedings first read above, constituting a fund called "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme" to provide financial assistance to the Pensioners for undergoing specialized treatments/Surgeries, when they are affected by major ailments. In the Board's Proceedings third read above, they were permitted to get reimbursement of the expenses incurred by them in taking treatment with the maximum ceiling limit of Rs.1,00,000/- or 75% of the actual cost of the treatments, whichever is less.

2. Subsequently, based on the orders of the Government, among other things, orders were issued in the Board's Proceedings fourth and fifth read above, extending the said benefits to the spouse of the Pensioners and enhancing the Pensioner's contribution towards the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioner's Health Fund Scheme from Rs.50/- to Rs.100/- Per month and extended the said Scheme to the Family Pensioners who are willing to enroll themselves under the scheme, by deducting the monthly subscription of Rs.75/- respectively.

3. Owing to extension of the scheme to the spouse of the Pensioners and Family Pensioners and also due to the extension of the facility for those Pensioners/Family Pensioners who have undergone treatment/surgery even in unaccredited hospitals, the claims received under the Tamil Nadu Government Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme increased enormously. The subscription collected from the Pensioners/Family Pensioners was not sufficient to meet the claims and hence, the Government, in its order seventh read above, have issued orders enhancing the monthly subscription for the said Scheme, payable by the Pensioners and Family Pensioners from Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and from Rs.75/- to Rs.100/- per month respectively, with effect from 01.01.2012 to avoid the ever increasing additional burden to the government and to make a breakeven point. As the TANGEDCO has already extended the same benefit to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners/Spouse of the Pensioners vide Proceedings fourth and fifth read above, enormous claims are received from the Pensioners/Family Pensioners under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund Scheme. In order to avoid insufficient fund position and to settle the claims of the Pensioners/Family Pensioners in time, a proposal has been placed before the Board of TANGEDCO to adopt the orders of the Government seventh read above in TANGEDCO, so as to enhance the monthly subscription towards Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme, 1995, as in the case of the Government. The Board has examined the said proposal in detail and decided to adopt the orders of the Government in TANGEDCO.

4. Accordingly, the TANGEDCO directs that the monthly subscription towards Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioner's Health Fund Scheme, 1995, payable by the Pensioners and Family Pensioners, be enhanced from Rs.100/- to Rs.150/- and from Rs.75/- to Rs.100/- per month respectively with effect from 01.03.2012 (i.e. the Pension/Family Pension to be payable on 01.04.2012).

5. There shall be no change in the other terms and conditions of the scheme.

6. The receipt of these proceedings shall be acknowledged in the slip enclosed.
