PROCEEDINGS:

Based on the orders of the Government, the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board in the Board's Proceedings first read above, had constituted a fund called "Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund" to provide financial assistance to pensioners for undergoing specialized treatment/Surgery, if they are affected by major ailments. The approved list of the Special treatments/surgeries and a list of Private Hospitals accredited were annexed to the said order to provide assistance from the fund to the pensioners for undergoing treatment. Subsequently, Eye surgery/treatment was also included under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund Scheme.

2. In the Board's Proceedings second read above, following the orders of the Government, orders were issued enclosing the list of diseases and list of accredited private hospitals for availing assistance by the Pensioners under this scheme. In the Board's Proceedings third read above, orders were issued to the effect that pensioners who undergo specialized advanced surgeries / treatments in respect of diseases which are included in the list approved under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund Scheme in unaccredited hospitals shall also be eligible for the maximum grant subject to the ceiling limit.

3. In the Government Order fourth read above, the Govt. have now issued orders for sanction of claims for medical assistance from the pensioners in respect of ineligible and eligible treatments in unaccredited institutions, both within the State and outside the State subject to certain condition. The Board has examined and decided to adopt the said orders of the Government to the Pensioners of Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Ltd., Tamil Nadu Transmission Corporation Ltd. and Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Limited.

4. Accordingly, the Tamil Nadu Generation and Distribution Corporation Ltd. directs that the pending claims as well as future claims for medical assistance from the pensioners in respect of ineligible treatments as well as eligible treatments taken in unaccredited institutions, both within the State as well as outside the State, shall also be eligible for sanction of assistance under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners Health Fund Scheme.

5. There shall be no change in the existing rules and conditions for sanction of assistance under the scheme.

6. This order shall take immediate effect.

7. The receipt of the Proceedings shall be acknowledged in the slip enclosed.


