

Memorandum (Per) No.68547 / A18 / 183 / 2011 - 1 dated 18.11.2011.

Sub: TANGEDCO - Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme - Extension of Scheme to Family Pensioners - Exercising the option - Extension of Time limit - Orders - Issued.

Ref: (Per) FE TANGEDCO Proceedings No.14 (SB) dated 18.12.2010.

In the TANGEDCO Proceedings cited, orders have been issued extending the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme to the Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO, TANTRANSOCO and TNEB Limited on certain conditions. One of the conditions laid down in the said Proceedings is that the existing Family Pensioners who are willing to enroll themselves in the said scheme and make a contribution of Rs.75/- per month to the fund from their monthly family pension till their death/till the payment of Family Pension ceases, should exercise option to the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Audit Branch within nine months from the date of issue of the said Proceedings (i.e. on or before 17.09.2011). It has also been ordered that if no such option is received from the existing Family Pensioners within the said period, it shall be construed that they are not willing to enroll themselves under the Scheme and the option once exercised is final.

2. Certain Pensioners' Associations of TANGEDCO have stated that most of the Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO are unaware of the orders issued in the Proceedings cited and hence, they have not exercised their willingness to enroll themselves in the scheme within the time limit prescribed. Hence, the said Associations have requested to extend the time limit for a further period of 3 months beyond 17.09.2011.

3. The request of the Pensioners' Associations have been carefully examined and it has been decided to accept their requests. Accordingly, it is hereby ordered that the time limit already fixed to the existing Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO (erstwhile Tamil Nadu Electricity Board) to exercise their willingness to enroll themselves under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme as ordered in the Proceedings cited, be extended up to 31.01.2012. It is also ordered that no further extension of time will be given thereafter. If no such option is received from the existing Family Pensioners on or before 31.01.2012, it shall be construed that they are not willing to enroll themselves under the Scheme.

4. In respect of the future cases, while sanctioning the Family Pension in respect of employees expired while in service, all the Pension Sanctioning Authorities shall obtain the willingness of the legal heirs of the deceased employees to enroll themselves under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme and forward the same along with the Pension Proposal to the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Audit Branch/Chennai for authorization. In the event of death of the Pensioner, the Chief Internal Audit Officer/Audit Branch/Chennai shall obtain the willingness of the

Family Pensioners to enroll themselves under the said Scheme, while authorizing the family pension to them.

Sub: TANGEDCO - Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme - Removal of ceiling for eye surgery - Orders - Issued.

Ref: (Per) (FB) TANGEDCO Proceedings No 15 (SB) dated 18.12.2010

The ceiling limit for eye surgery (Cataract) to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO (erstwhile Tamil Nadu Electricity Board) under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme was fixed at Rs.6,500/-. Subsequently, during 2007, the ceiling limit was enhanced from Rs.6,500/- to Rs.10,000/- per eye.

2. In the TANGEDCO Proceedings cited, orders have been issued, permitting the Pensioners (for self/spouse) and Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO to avail the ineligible treatments as well as eligible treatments in accredited and unaccredited institutions both within the State as well as outside the State with a maximum financial assistance under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme at Rs.1,00,000/- or 75% of the actual cost of treatments, whichever is less.

3. Consequent on the issuance of the said Proceedings, certain Pensioners' Associations of TANGEDCO have been requesting to remove the maximum ceiling limit of Rs.10,000/- fixed for eye surgery (Cataract) under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme. Their requests have been examined in detail and it has been decided to remove the maximum ceiling limit.

4. Accordingly, it is hereby ordered that the ^{maximum} ceiling limit in sanctioning financial assistance under the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board Pensioners' Health Fund Scheme for eye surgery (Cataract) to the Pensioners (for self/spouse) and Family Pensioners of TANGEDCO is removed, subject to the maximum financial assistance of Rs.1,00,000/- or 75% of the actual cost of treatments, whichever is less irrespective of the nature of diseases as ordered in the Proceedings cited.

5. It is also hereby ordered that the above orders shall be applicable only for the pending and future claims and the settled claims need not be reopened.
